Variable Frequency Drives (VFDs) for HVAC Equipment

Product Eligibility Requirements

- Visit www.efficiencyvermont.com/rebates to determine the rebate amount for eligible applications (see table at right).
- VFDs must be new and cannot replace existing VFDs. Replacement VFDs may be eligible for custom incentives. Call for more information.
- VFDs must be controlled by an automatic signal (such as differential pressure, flow, or temperature).
- NOT eligible: forward-curve fans with inlet guide vanes, variable pitch vane-axial fans, circulation pumps with integral variable speed technology, and VFD installations required by the 2015 Vermont Commercial Building Energy Standards (CBES).

applications and larger systems. Call 888-921-5990 for more information.

- For projects within the city of Burlington: For VFDs >10 HP, rebates are only available with pre-approval by BED. To discuss your specific project in more detail, please call 802-865-7342.
- Residential applications and new construction projects are not eligible for this rebate.

Product Eligibility Requirements

- Customers of Burlington Electric Department and VGS are not eligible for this rebate.
- Visit www.efficiencyvermont.com/rebates to determine the rebate amount.
- Equipment must be installed by an Efficiency Excellence Network HVAC-Central Wood Pellet Heating Systems contractor. A list of participating contractors is available at efficiencyvermont.com/CWPHScontractors.
- Rebates are for new, high-efficiency wood pellet boilers or furnaces installed as primary central heating systems in homes or businesses.
- Contact Efficiency Vermont for installations in commercial spaces over 5,000 sq. ft
- Systems must be pellet-only and must be classified as indoor systems and installed inside.
- Systems must have at least 1 ton fuel-storage and automated on/off and fuel feed.

- Commercial new construction projects are not eligible for this rebate, but may be eligible for custom incentives. Contact Efficiency Vermont to learn more.

Program Eligibility and Exclusions

Rebate cannot be combined with any other Efficiency Vermont offer (including point of purchase discounts) and is subject to change without notice. Rebate must be submitted on or after the program/offer "effective date" and within 365 days of the product purchase date. In the event a rebate is discontinued or changed, submissions will be honored at the higher amount if the qualifying product was purchased prior to the effective date of the change, with installations and rebate submission occurring within 30 calendar days of the change.

All equipment must be new, installed in Vermont, and listed on the Qualifying Products List (or meet Efficiency Vermont qualifying criteria) at the time of purchase. Used, rebuilt, or refurbished equipment is not eligible.

Customers of Burlington Electric Department and VGS are not eligible for the Central Wood Pellet Furnaces and Boilers rebate.

Income is defined as the total annual gross income of all family and non-family members living within the household. To calculate income, take the monthly amount from the last one to two paychecks for yourself and the people in your household (before taxes) and multiply by 12. Include all wages including regular salaries and overtime. If you are self-employed, use the previous month of pretax income and multiply by 12. All sources of income must be counted from all persons in the household based on anticipated income expected within the next 12 months.

Possible types of income include but are not limited to: wages, salary, tips, bonuses or commissions payments, public assistance, social security/SSI, child support, regular gifts, unemployment, income earned on assets (Savings, IRA, etc.) and some types of financial aid.

Payment will not exceed the purchase price, and excludes all other costs including shipping, sales tax, or disposal/recycling expenses (installation costs of HVAC and refrigeration equipment, and installation and freight costs of agricultural equipment are eligible). Customer is responsible for any tax liability associated with rebate payment. Allow 60 calendar days for delivery of payment. Incomplete or missing information will delay processing.

IBM, Global Foundries, Omya, and Vermont electric utility companies are not eligible.
