- **Quieter work space:** Variable frequency drive controllers and new efficient fans may decrease noise levels.
- **Lower maintenance costs:** Equipment may last longer and require less routine maintenance.
- **Lower labor costs:** Some equipment may save time when completing a task on the farm.
- **Improved product:** Some equipment may improve product quality and quantity.
- **More efficient use of square footage:** Equipment consolidation frees up space.

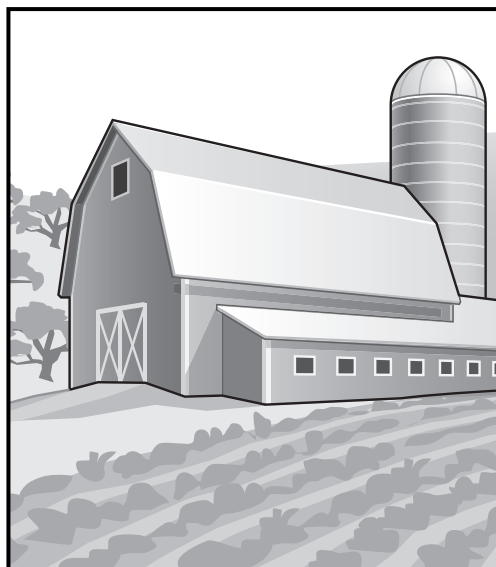
