Air Sealing and Insulation

Work with an EEN contractor: 75% off eligible project costs, up to \$4,000. Moderate income Vermonters get 75% off, up to \$9,500; low-income Vermonters get 90% off, up to \$9,500, while funding lasts. Federal Tax Credit: 30% of cost

DIY: \$100 back for completing an eligible project, like weatherizing windows / doors, adding storm windows, or sealing air leaks in your attic and basement.

Need help paying for improvements?

Financing options start at 0% interest with no money down. Or pay for a weatherization project monthly on your utility bill (for participating electric and gas utilities).

Heating, Cooling, and Water Heating

Heat pumps:

Air-to-water: \$1,000/ton rebate for qualifying equipment

+ \$500 income bonus

Ducted: discount starting at \$1,200 at participating distributors

+ \$200 income bonus

Federal Tax Credit: 30% of cost, up to \$2,000 per year

Ductless: discount starting at \$500 at participating distributors

+ \$200 income bonus

Federal Tax Credit: 30% of cost, up to \$2,000 per year

Ground source: up to \$2,100/ton rebate for qualifying equipment

+ \$500 income bonus

Federal Tax Credit: 30% of cost

Integrated controls for ductless heat pumps: up to \$600 rebate for qualifying equipment

High-performance circulator pumps: \$15-\$50 discount at participating distributors

Smart thermostats: up to \$100 rebate for select ENERGY STAR models

Water heaters: \$600 for select heat pump water heaters

+ up to 100% of costs covered for income-eligible households

Federal Tax Credit: 30% of cost, up to \$2,000 per year

Window air conditioners: \$100 rebate for ENERGY STAR Most Efficient models

Federal Tax Credit: 30% of cost, up to \$600

Wood pellet furnaces & boilers: \$6,000 rebate.

Federal Tax Credit: 30% of cost, up to \$2,000 per year

Wood pellet and cord wood stoves: \$400 discount at participating retailers

Federal Tax Credit: 30% of cost, up to \$2,000 per year





Appliances

Rebates on select ENERGY STAR models:

Dehumidifiers: \$25-\$40

Heat pump clothes dryers: \$200-\$400 Heat pump washer/dryer combo units: \$400



Lighting & Electrical

LEDs for indoor growing: \$100 rebate for qualifying fixtures



Income Assistance

Lower-income renters and homeowners may be eligible for free appliances, energy audits, weatherization, heat pumps, LEDs and more. Call to determine your eligibility.



Electric Vehicles

Federal tax credit: up to \$7,500; Electric utility incentive: \$500-\$2,500 Income-eligible Vermonters can get up to \$5,000 or more on a used EV through MileageSmartVT.org

Additional rebates may be available from your electric utility company.
