Eligibility & Exclusions

Rebate must be submitted on or after the program/offer "effective date" and within 365 days of the product purchase date. In the event a rebate is discontinued or changed, submissions will be honored at the higher amount if the qualifying product was purchased prior to the effective date of the change, with installations and rebate submission occurring within 30 calendar days of that date.
