Program Eligibility and Exclusions

Rebate can be combined with other Efficiency Vermont offers (including point of purchase discounts).

If you received an Efficiency Vermont incentive of less than \$10,000 for damages incurred due to 2023 flooding and your home incurred additional damages during 2024 flooding, you may reapply for an incentive up to the amount that brings your 2023 and 2024 Efficiency Vermont flood incentive total up to \$10,000.

Rebate is subject to change without notice. Rebate must be submitted on or after the program/offer "effective date" of July 10, 2023, and within 365 days of the product purchase date if funds are available. In the event this rebate is discontinued or changed, submissions will be processed at the new rebate level as of the date of the change, or will not be accepted if the funds are exhausted.

All equipment must be new, installed in Vermont, and listed on the Qualifying Products List (or meet Efficiency Vermont qualifying criteria) at the time of purchase. Used, rebuilt, or refurbished equipment is not eligible.

For any single item, payment will not exceed the net price to the customer, including any benefits and payments received from insurance, FEMA, and any other donations, or grants and includes all other costs including shipping, sales tax, or disposal/recycling expenses (installation costs of HVAC and water heating equipment are eligible).

Customer is responsible for any tax liability associated with rebate payment. Allow 60 calendar days for delivery of payment. Incomplete or missing information will delay processing.

Income Eligibility for Residential Households

Residential customers are eligible to receive this benefit if their household income is at or below the income guidelines. Income is defined as the total annual gross income of all family and non-family members living within the household. To calculate income, take the monthly amount from the last one or two paychecks for yourself and the people in your household (before taxes) and multiply by 12. Include all wages, including regular salaries and overtime. If you are self-employed, use the previous month of pretax income and multiply by 12.

All sources of income must be counted from all persons in the household based on anticipated income expected within the next 12 months. Possible types of income include but are not limited to: wages, salary, tips, bonuses or commissions payments, public assistance, social security/SSI, child support, regular gifts, unemployment, income earned on assets (savings, IRA, etc.) and some types of financial aid.
