## **Program Eligibility and Exclusions**

Offer is only available for residential customers of Vermont electric utilities. Offer is subject to change without notice. Rebate can be combined with other Efficiency Vermont offers (including point of purchase discounts).

Rebate is subject to change without notice. Request for pre-approval of rebate must be submitted on or after the offer "effective date" of October 1st, 2024. After the project has been pre-approved by Efficiency Vermont and completed by your contractor, the rebate request must be submitted prior to the expiration of the "Completed Project Information Deadline" that will be shown on the project pre-approval issued by Efficiency Vermont.

Rebate is subject to availability of funds.

Rebate offer and Rebate is subject to change without notice. In the event this rebate is offer is discontinued or changed, submissions will be processed at the new rebate level under the revised terms as of the data of the change, but will not be accepted if the program has been discontinued of if funds are exhausted.

All equipment must be new and, installed in Vermont, and listed on the Qualifying Products List (or meet Efficiency Vermont qualifying criteria) at the time of purchase. Used, rebuilt, or refurbished equipment is not eligible. For residential customers only.

Rebate can be combined with other Efficiency Vermont offers (including point of purchase discounts). However, for any single item, payment will not exceed the net price to the customer, including any other rebates and discounts, benefits and payments received from insurance, FEMA, and any other donations, or grants and includes price of the allowable equipment and materials, all other costs including shipping, sales tax, and disposal/recycling expenses. Customer is responsible for any tax liability associated with rebate payment. Allow 60 calendar days for delivery of payment. Incomplete or missing information will delay processing. Customer is responsible for any maintenance, service, and repair of the installed equipment and for pursuing customer's rights under any manufacturer's or installer's warranty.

#### Income Eligibility for Residential Households

Residential customers are eligible to receive this benefit if their household income is at or below the income guidelines. Income is defined as the total annual gross income of all family and non-family members living within the household. To calculate income, take the monthly amount from the last one or two paychecks for yourself and the people in your household (before taxes) and multiply by 12. Include all wages, including regular salaries and overtime. If you are self-employed, use the previous month of pretax income and multiply by 12.

All sources of income must be counted from all persons in the household based on anticipated income expected within the next 12 months. Possible types of income include but are not limited to wages, salary, tips, bonuses or commissions payments, public assistance, social security/SSI, child support, regular gifts, unemployment, income earned on assets (savings, IRA, etc.) and some types of financial aid.
