In the event it is discontinued or changed, submissions will be honored if the qualifying product/project was paid for prior to the effective date of the change, with installations and rebate submission occurring within 30 calendar days after that date. Allow 60 calendar days for delivery of payment. Incomplete or missing information will delay processing. Limit one bonus per household. You are eligible to receive a bonus rebate if your income is at or below the income guidelines listed on page 1. Income is defined as the total annual gross income of all family and non-family members 18+ years old living within the household. To calculate income, take the monthly amount from the last one-to-two paychecks for yourself and the people in your household (before taxes) and multiply by 12. Include all wages, including regular salaries and overtime. If you are self-employed, use the previous month of pretax income and multiply by 12.

All sources of income must be counted from all persons in the household based on anticipated income expected within the next 12 months. Possible types of income include but are not limited to: wages, salary, tips, bonuses or commissions payments, public assistance, social security/SSI, child support, regular gifts, unemployment, income earned on assets (savings, IRA, etc.) and some types of financial aid.
