4 Elements of “Advanced”

Support for AWH

- Residential/Sm. Commercial Rebates (Rebate Forms)
- Large Commercial Rebates (Custom)
- State Tax Exemption
- Financing
- Stove Incentives (coming)

Rebate Forms

- For central pellet boilers/furnaces
- Residential Heating Systems form
 - Use when system serves one dwelling unit
- Commercial HVAC form
 - Up to 5000 ft²
 - All commercial and central MF
- Qualified Product List

Rebate Forms – cont.

- Combined EVT/CEDF rebates into 1 form
- $\$3,000 + \$3,000 = \$6,000$
 - CEDF portion MUST go to contractor
 - EVT portion can go to contractor or customer
- Online Rebate Center (Commercial Only)
 - Customer must fill out
 - Provides access to EVT & CEDF rebates

Commercial Custom Program

- \$1.25/ft² of heated space connected to the installed wood heating system (pellets or chips)
- >5000 ft²
- No forms to fill out
- Just give us a call – (888) 921-5990

VT State Tax Exemption

- Went into effect July 1, 2018
- For equipment that directly contributes to the operation of the system
 - E.g. boiler, fuel storage, conveyance equipment
 - Other parts of the system such as distribution
NOT exempt
- Exemption amount MUST be displayed on customer invoice
- Contact the State Tax Dept. for more info

Financing

- Heat Saver Loan (Residential)
 - Low Interest
 - Easy, quick qualification
- Business Energy Loan (Commercial)
 - No closing costs, \$0 down
 - For all qualifying efficiency improvements
