To: Energy Savings Account (ESA) Pilot Program Participants

Re: Weatherization and Gross Receipts Tax on Energy Savings Accounts

Dear ESA Pilot Program Participant:

This letter is to confirm that you are aware of the required Weatherization Tax (0.5%) and Gross Receipts Tax (0.525%) associated with your total Energy Savings Account (ESA) funds balance. The collection of these taxes is applied to all energy efficiency charge collections in Vermont.¹ As such your "net" available ESA funds balance will be an amount equal to your energy efficiency charge collections minus the required taxes.
